

## **FAMILY AGREEMENT**

1. We have carefully examined and agree with the Christian purpose and doctrinal basis of El Camino Academy (ECA) and desire that ECA works with us in the education of our children.
2. We pledge our loyalty to the goals and objectives of ECA and will bring any and all questions and problems directly to the appropriate teacher or to the administration, so that they may be properly considered by those in authority.
3. We pledge ourselves to perform services, when qualified and needed, as we are able, and to uphold ECA consistently in family prayer.
4. We understand that ECA agrees to work closely with us in helping our children learn. This includes provision of competent teachers, a full and balanced curriculum, regular reporting, supervision of the children and the program, and cooperation with the home. We understand that the teachers and administration will work with us if there should be a need for disciplining our children or dealing with any problems. We agree to work with the staff in resolving any problems, that might arise.
5. We understand that ECA reserves the right to dismiss any student who does not cooperate with the educational process.
6. In full support of ECA, we will regularly attend the Parent Teacher Fellowship (PTF) events, parent conferences, grade level prayer meetings and other school functions.
7. We understand that it is our responsibility to read and discuss with our children their progress reports and report cards.
8. We recognize that it is our responsibility to read and understand all written communication from the school. If English is not our native language and recognizing that the school's official language is English, we will find ways to translate English bulletins, memos, fliers, grades, and any other notes, forms or letters that the school sends, into our native language, so we can fulfill our responsibilities as parents.
9. We are committed to support our child/ren to reinforce English or any other academic area by giving support with homework assignments and providing tutoring after school or during vacation when necessary or when recommended by the school.
10. We understand that the school is responsible for supervision only for planned school activities that are previously announced in the weekly bulletin or that have had a permission slip sent home. All other events sponsored by individual families are the responsibility of each family to check out and determine appropriateness.
11. We understand all students are accepted on a probationary basis for the first year.
